DSR seeks to appoint a Youth Worker, based in King Williams

This post focuses on but is not limited to masculinity, positive conceptions of femaleness and femininity, gender-based violence prevention, education and awareness about sex, sexuality and violence, sexual reproductive health rights, HIV/AIDS and community engagement.

**The successful candidate will be appointed on a part time basis**

### **Responsibilities:**

Training partners and other stakeholders on the programme; and implementing the programme with youth.

Youth Club: developing and implementing a youth club which focuses on issues affecting young people, the weekly and monthly programme sessions, and measuring the impact of the programme.

Community engagement in the form of talks, workshops and campaigns that focus on gender-related issues, such as domestic violence, and gender-based violence prevention.

Other gender-based programming, as and when the need arises.

Monitoring and evaluation: administration of intervention pre- and post tests, and administration of client focus groups.

Maintenance of accurate service statistics: updating service statistics weekly.

Submit accurate service statistics to the Program Manager for the monthly report.

Assist the Program Manager with other tasks, as and when needed

### **Requirements**

- Age 18 – 25years. As the youth program is part of a Women's program, women will be given preference who reside in the area close to KWT.
- A Grade 12 certificate;
- NQF 5 qualification at least

- Ability to work as part of a team in an organisation which upholds principles of non-partisanship, non-discrimination, and unprejudiced acceptance of all people, irrespective of religious affiliation, sexual orientation, or cultural association;
- Proven leadership and conflict management skills;
- Ability to facilitate workshops, make presentations;
- Excellent interpersonal skills;
- Fully computer literate in the following; Microsoft Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Internet and Outlook
- At least 5 years experience in rural communities facilitating sexual and reproduction health education; gender-based violence prevention amongst youth
- Administration skills;
- Time management skills;
- Ability to manage multiple tasks at once;
- Verbal and written skills in English and isiXhosa;
- Be comfortable working in King Williams Town and surrounding areas on a daily basis;
- Ability to work well with people from a variety of different groups (language, ethnicity, age, race and nationality)
